Dear Parent/Carer of:

Your child's attendance for autumn term 2021 was %. Your child is currently on **Red** (See box below for details).

Our current attendance target range for all children is 96%-100% and unfortunately your child is not currently meeting this target. Therefore, we are sending you this letter to bring this to your attention, as any child with below 90% attendance is considered by the Department for Education to be a "persistent absentee".

We appreciate that there are a number of factors that can cause your child to be absent from school and some of these are unavoidable, such as COVID-19 and sickness. However, for persistent absentees, the school is expected to have plans in place to both support children and to improve their attendance.

We would like to offer you an opportunity to improve your child's attendance with support from the school. Therefore, we will contact you within the next few days to arrange a meeting, either in person or by telephone. Please note that this is a positive approach to encourage all our children to have good attendance.
