Levers	a bar resting on a pivot, used to move a heavy object.	
Join	To link or connect.	
Pivot	the central point, pin, or shaft on which a mechanism turns	
Pull	Exert force on something to move it towards you.	
Push	Exert force on something to move it away from you.	
Slider	A lever that is moved horizontally or vertically to control an object.	
Wheels	A circular object that revolves on an axle and is fixed	
Fastener	To secure or close something.


