


## Year 2 – Spring term Puppets

<u>Key Vocabulary</u>	
Puppet	a model of an animal that is moved by the hand inside
Stitch	A loop of thread that holds two pieces of material together
Thread	A thin strand that goes through the needle to create the stitch
Needle	A thin piece of metal or plastic that uses thread to attach the pieces of material
Materials	The pieces that are put together with the needle and thread
Knotting	To tie a knot in the thread you are sewing with
Embellishments	Something that stands out to make the puppet more attractive













## **Lesson sequence**

Evaluation of existing products	To know that there are many different types of puppets.  To know that there are different ways of making puppets move.  To know that in different cultures puppets have different meanings.  To know that puppets have different purposes.
Focussed tasks	To know that there are different types of puppet.  To know that the different types of puppets are for different reasons.  To look at how puppets are made.  To design a puppet of an Arctic animal.  To practice safely sewing the material together.  To effectively and safely sew the two pieces of material for the puppet together.
Design	To know that the design should be of an easily identifiable and realistic Arctic animal .
Make	To know that it is important to ensure the pieces of material are joined together safely. To make sure the decoration of the puppet is realistic.
Evaluate	To be able to evaluate their work against the design they made.  To be able to evaluate the work of others in a positive and fair way.
Health and Safety	To be able to use the sewing equipment safely and accurately.
