
Discover core vocabulary

Species	A group of closely related organisms that are very similar to each other
Variation	A change or small difference
Inherited	The way a trait or characteristic is passed to offspring from parents




Charles Darwin

Naturalist, biologist and geologist. He proposed that all species of life had descended over time from common ancestors. Wrote 'The Origin of the Species'




Galapagos Finches
