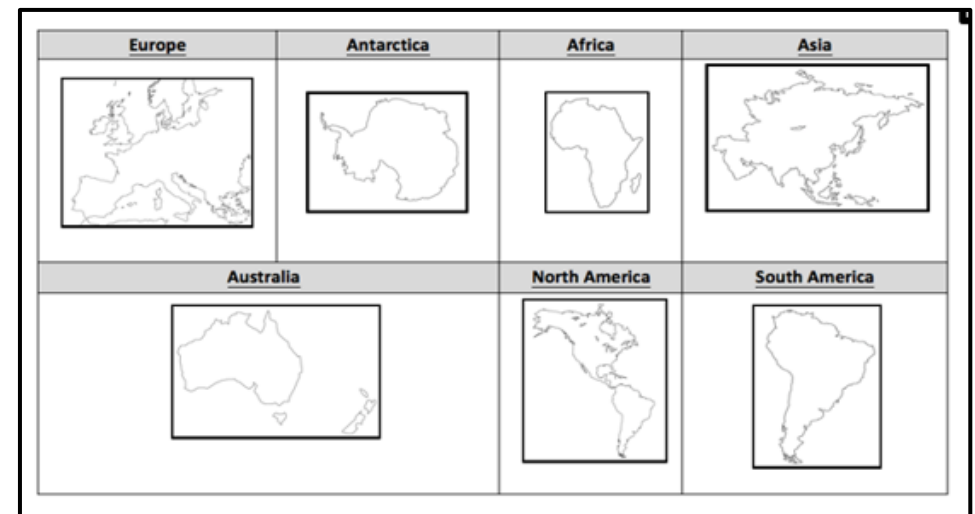

The Seven Continents



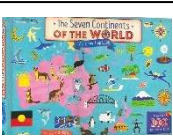
Key Vocabulary	Definition
Earth	The planet we live on
Globe	A rounded model of our Earth
Continent	One of the world's seven main areas of land
Climate	The weather conditions in an area over a long period of time
Ocean	A wide expanse of sea
North Hemisphere	The part of the earth which is north of the equator
Southern Hemisphere	The part of the earth which is south of the equator
Equator	An imaginary line drawn on the earth dividing the earth into the northern and southern hemispheres

The land masses on Earth have been divided up into seven continuous expanses of land called continents

The seven continents are; Europe, Asia, Africa, Antarctica, North America, South America and Australia

Australia, the continent, is sometimes referred to as Australasia or Oceania depending on which islands the definition is encompassing. For this unit, we are using the term 'Australia'.

The five oceans are; The Pacific Ocean, The Atlantic Ocean, The Indian Ocean, The Southern Ocean and the Arctic Ocean
