Unit Title	Livin' On A Prayer
Unit Theme	Rock Anthems
Style of Music	Rock
Supporting Songs	We Will Rock You by Queen Smoke On The Water by Deep Purple Rockin' All Over The World by Status Quo Johnny B. Goode by Chuck Berry I Saw Her Standing There by The Beatles

Key Vocabulary	
Rock	Genre characterised by loud guitars and drums due to the heavy amplification, strong bass line and driving rhythms
Structure	The sections (verses and choruses etc.) of a song
Bridge	Contrasting section which leads back to main material
Backbeat	Beats 2 and 4 in a drum-line
Riff	A short repeated phrase, often played on a lead instrument
Improvise	To make up a tune and play it on the spot
Compose	Create and develop musical ideas

Lesson 1

Listen to Livin' On A Prayer and look at coloured timetable which denotes the sections

Vocal warm-ups

Start to learn to sing the song and perform

Lesson 2

Listen to We Will Rock You and answer questions using correct musical language

Vocal warm-ups and sing song

Use instruments and perform

Lesson 3

Listen to Smoke On The Water and compare to previous songs

Flexible games - do challenges

Continue to play instruments. Perform with the song with singing and instruments

Listen to Rockin' All Over The World, find pulse and answer questions about structure and dynamics

Warm-up games

Improvisation activities

Lesson 5

Listen to Johnny B. Goode discuss riff and hook and compare to previous songs

Sing Livin' On A Prayer

Composition activities and perform

Lesson 6

Listen to I Saw Her Standing There. Identify structure, hook, riff and dynamics

Use instruments to play song

Continue composition activities then reflect on learning
