



Year 5 Cricket

Key Vocabulary

Wicket	Sets of three stumps with two bails across the top at either end of the pitch
Crease	Any of a number of lines marked on the pitch at specified places
Stumps	The three vertical posts that support the bails and form the wicket.
Boundary	Perimeter of the playing field.
Innings	A unit of play in which each team has a turn at bat, the turn of a team ending after ten players are put out or when the team declares.
Over	An over consists of six consecutive legal deliveries bowled
Four	Number of points scored if a ball is hit out of the boundary.
Six	Number of points scored if a ball is hit out of the boundary without bouncing.
Cross	Hitting the ball with the bat parallel to the ground.
