	Key Vocabulary
Dynamics	Different parts of performance to music.
Assemblé	An assemble in dance refers to a jump completed from one to both feet
Sissone	Sissonne is a classical ballet term that describes a dancer jumping from two feet and splitting their legs "like scissors" in the air before landing.
Sauté	Jumped, jumping.
Gesture	A dance in which steps are emphasised.
Chainé	A turning movement in which the dancer executes a half turn on each foot.
Retrograde	Turning in the opposite direction to others.
Fragmentation	Divide up the dance phases.




