Key Vocabulary

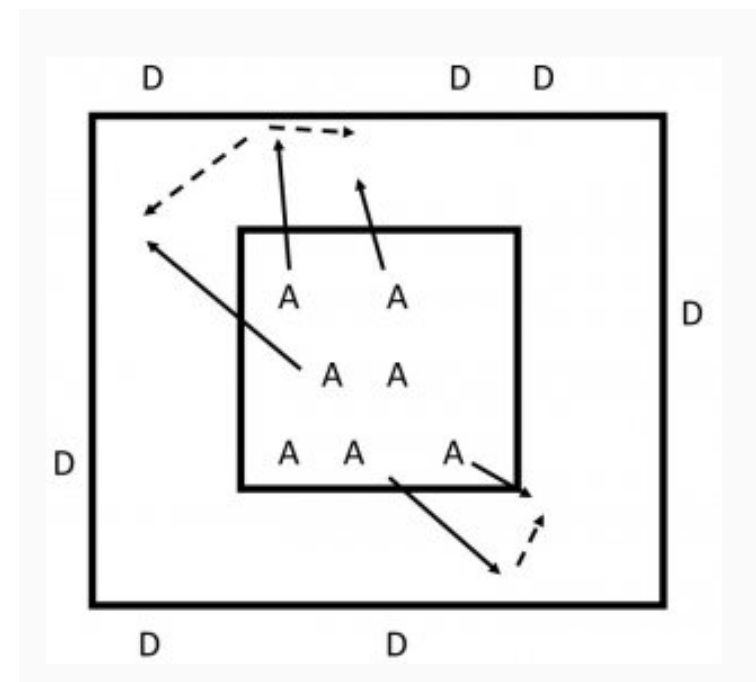
Tag	To tag or remove one of the tags from the ball carriers belt.
Space	To continually scan for and identify space during a game.
Try-area	To score a goal in the opposition's goal area.
defend	To stop the other team from scoring .
retain	To keep possession of the ball.
possession	To gain territory or possession of the game.
pressure	To attack the opposing team.
Teamwork	To organise and work together passing the ball.
