Key Questions:

Do I know how to save money?

Do I know how to earn money?

Do I recognise my special qualities?

What I am proud of about myself?

What do others like about me?

How would I get help if there was accident?

Who are the special people that can help in an emergency?



Time:
4 hours 30 minutes

Core Knowledge:

- **L6 – to learn that money comes from different sources and can be used for different purposes, including the concepts of spending and saving**
- **L7 – to learn about the role money plays in their lives including how to keep it safe, choices about spending or saving money and what influences those choices**
- **L8 – to learn ways in which they are all unique; understand that there has never been and will never be another ‘them’**
- **L9 – to learn ways in which we are the same as other people; what we have in common with everyone else**
- **L10 – to learn about the ‘special people’ who work in their community and who are responsible for looking after them and protecting them; how people contact those special people when they need their help, including dialling 999 in an emergency.**

Lesson 1:

Lesson 2:

Do I know the difference between needs and wants and that people may not always be able to have the things they want?
Do I know how to keep money safe and the different ways of doing this?

Do I understand what makes me special and unique?

Lesson 4:

Do I know the ways in which I am same as others and how we all have things in common?

Lesson 5:

Do I know that people have different role in the community to help them keep safe? Do I know who can help me in different places and situations?

Do I know how to get help if there is an accident, including how to dial 999 in an emergency?
