- ❖ It is vital that your child finds learning to read and write a rewarding and successful experience.





We are delighted to tell you that we have recently invested in a new scheme to help our children develop their literacy skills.

Read Write Inc., developed by Ruth Miskin, provides a structured and systematic approach to teaching literacy. It is used by more than a quarter of the UK's primary schools and is designed to create fluent readers, confident speakers and willing writers. Each Read Write Inc. programme meets the higher expectations of the new curriculum and uses effective assessment to accelerate every child's progress. At the moment, our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes are having Read Write Inc lessons every morning after the register. This will shortly being rolled out to our junior classes. It is absolutely crucial that your child is in school promptly to ensure that they take part in this lesson every day.
