Key Vocabulary	Definition
Wild plants	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows
Garden plants	Garden plants are plants people choose to group in their gardens
Deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year
Evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all
Roots	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil
Petals	Petals are colourful part of the flower
Leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to make energy
Stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots

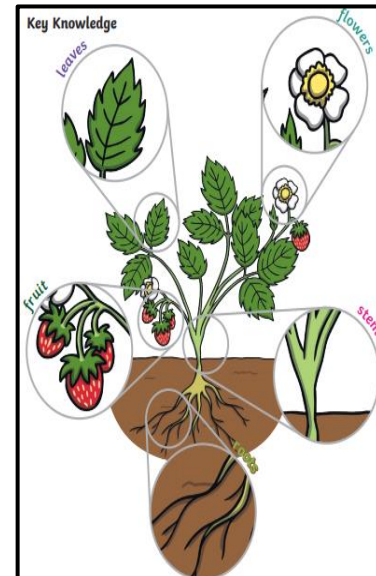

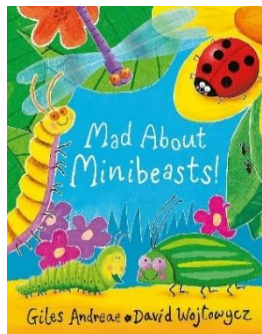
